

## 2.2 Change SEO settings for mega dropdown

To change the settings regarding the megadropdown, open the home page and activate the Metadata Schema "Page Metadata". Scroll down to the field "Activate following links in megadropdown navigation (should be used on homepage)". Click on the dropdown and select "true."

Save and close the page and republish.
